#### 1. About This Skill Set

MARSS00008 provides essential safety skills required for working safely on board commercial vessels. It covers emergency response, firefighting procedures, survival techniques, and work health and safety obligations in the maritime environment.

Completion of this skill set contributes to the **safety training requirements for various maritime roles** but **does not result in the issue of an AMSA Certificate of Competency**.

This skill set is delivered under the **Career Boost Program (General Pathway)**, meaning eligible students may access one subsidised maritime safety skill set as part of their Career Boost entitlement.

## 2. Total Costs (Co-Contribution Fees)

Non-concessional fee: \$100Concessional fee: \$50

#### How fees are charged:

- Maximum 30% upfront
- Remainder payable by the final day of training

Fees represent the total cost to the student. Training & Personnel Australia does not charge additional materials fees or any fees for developing Training Plans or Training Records.

The MARSS00008 Shipboard Safety Skill Set consists of 4 core units:

- 1. MARF028 Follow procedures to minimise and fight fires on board a vessel
- 2. MARF029 Meet work health and safety requirements
- 3. MARF030 Survive at sea using survival craft
- 4. MARF060 Apply basic survival skills in the event of vessel abandonment

### 5. Requirements for Successful Completion

Students must successfully complete all 4 units of competency and participate in all required practical training activities conducted during the course.

There is **no vocational placement** required for this qualification.

# 7. Funding Entitlement – Career Boost Program (General Pathway)

This skill set is subsidised by the Queensland Government under the Career Boost Program.

Under Career Boost, eligible students may access:

- One subsidised general-pathway qualification, and
- Up to two subsidised skill sets

Students must pay a co-contribution fee.

Students will not be subsidised for:

- repeating the skill set, or
- enrolling in more than two subsidised skill sets under Career Boost.

Foundation skills training and training completed while at school do **not** affect Career Boost eligibility. Enrolling in this skill set will use one of the student's **skill set entitlements** under the Career Boost Program.
